BSCCP Criteria for International Colposcopy Courses and meetings

Attendance at International Colposcopy courses and meetings for the purposes of re-certification will be accepted if the following criteria are shown to have been fulfilled.

- The organising body must be part of a national colposcopy society who is affiliated to the IFCPC or EFC and the content must be relevant to current colposcopy practice internationally and in your own country.
- A minimum of 6 hours or more content is required on topical or recent issues relevant to colposcopy.
- It should be possible to assess Quality Assurance standards.

A copy of the programme should be submitted in addition to the certificate of attendance at the time of re-certification to Elaine.radford@bwnft.nhs.uk for consideration and approval by the BSCCP Certification and Training Committee which meets twice a year in February and September.

Organisers of colposcopy courses or scientific meetings may apply to the BSCCP Certification and Training Committee for approval and recognition prior to the meeting being held. A copy of the programme should be emailed to Elaine.radford@bwnft.nhs.uk.
