Course Overview:

This Colposcopy Course is a one-day course suitable for trained colposcopists seeking to advance their knowledge as well as those more experienced who are wishing to gain BSCCP re-certification.

The course has been submitted for BSCCP approval.

It is suitable for BSCCP accredited colposcopists who are intermediate to advanced in their level of the knowledge and treatment of cervical premalignant disease and other lower genital tract intraepithelial neoplasia's. It reflects the latest advances in colposcopy and the NHSCSP, including the role of HPV testing, HPV vaccination, management issues as well as clinical knowledge in lower genital tract diagnoses and treatment.

Learning Outcomes:

To provide delegates with an update on the latest advances in colposcopy and related subjects, thus enabling them to gain re-accreditation. Topics covered will allow participants to;

- Understand the biology, epidemiology and natural history of HPV.
- Discuss the clinical use of HPV testing / high-risk HPV diagnosis and its relation to screening, triage, and treatment of pre-invasive neoplasia of the lower genital tract.
- Be aware of potential changes caused to service by roll out of HPV primary screening.
- Discuss the varying management of CIN2 and multifocal disease.
- Be aware of current statistics and research relating to HPV vaccination.
- Gain an understanding of the role of quality assurance, training and education in colposcopy.
- Gain an understanding of some of the new technologies available to the Colposcopist.
- Be aware of recent research and possible future directions in screening.
- Be aware of the clinical significance of persistent HR-HPV positive, cytology negative samples.

Who may attend?

This course is not suitable for those with little or no experience in the area of colposcopy. It is suitable for those trained and practicing in colposcopy from both nursing and medical backgrounds, as well as trainees in the latter stages of their qualification who want to broaden their knowledge.
