# **Specific Responsibilities**

- 1. To oversee the recertification process of Colposcopists and Trainers.
- 2 To liaise with the secretariat to organise and chair 2 CTC sub-committee meetings annually.
- 3. To liaise with the secretariat in the organisation and approval of Basic and Advanced colposcopy courses
- 4. To write the programme for the annual BSCCP Trainers Seminar.
- 5. To be available to advise on the OSCE exam and OSCE Preparation Course where necessary.
- 6. To deal appropriately with questions or complaints arising from the OSCE exam or the Joint Training Programme.
