

BSCCP Criteria for International Colposcopy Courses and Meetings

- Attendance at International Colposcopy courses and meetings for the purposes of re-accreditation will be accepted if the following criteria are shown to have been fulfilled.
- 2. The organising body must be part of a national colposcopy society who is affiliated to the IFCPC or EFC and the content must be relevant to current colposcopy practice internationally and in your own country.
- 3. A minimum of 6 hours or more content is required on topical or recent issues relevant to colposcopy.
- 4. It should be possible to assess Quality Assurance standards.
- Organisers of colposcopy courses or scientific meetings may apply to the BSCCP Certification and Training Committee for approval and recognition prior to the meeting being held. A copy of the programme should be emailed to <u>Elaine.radford2@nhs.net</u>

Important update from January 2019

- 1. The BSCCP policy is that course organiser's request endorsement at least 4 months in advance.
- 2. The BSCCP will not endorse courses retrospectively for BSCCP members to use for reaccreditation purposes.
- 3. The BSCCP does not seek courses to approve and will only give approval to those courses when approached by the course organisers.
